Meeting was called to order at 6:31 P.M.

Minutes from September Meeting

1. All approve

Treasurer Report

- 1. Concessions from the Muskogee game brought in about \$12,000
- 2. Renee Huffaker shared the BBPO Profit & Loss statement from 7/1-10/3
 - Income looks a little lower than previous years due to the fact that profits from BTOB haven't been received yet, whereas in prior years BTOB had been included at this point
 - The Coweta Band is not attending BTOB this year, which may impact concession profits
 - There will probably be multiple bank deposits made for BTOB money to avoid the headache of one big deposit last year
- 3. Mia Iden reported that 8th Grade Charms accounts have been set up to receive deposits for the London trip
 - The October deposits for London are non-refundable
 - Mr. Baldwin is managing the coordination of London deposits for the middle school
 - We are looking into setting up separate Charms accounts for London Chaperones

Fundraising Report

- 1. Tracy Rubis reported that Ken has many ideas he is trying to get implemented for fundraising opportunities
 - We are trying to get on the October agenda for fundraising approval
 - There are 10 fundraising options available over the next 12 months
 - See attachment on fundraiser specifics
 - If students average \$500 per fund raiser, London should be accessible for everyone
- 2. A Pride alumni works for Hobby Town and is willing to donate items for ticket raffles
- 3. Midfirst Bank Coin Match is another possible fundraiser
 - They bring the coin machine to an event and will match all donations brought during said event

- It may be possible to set cute buckets at businesses around town asking for coin donations that can be picked up prior to the event
- 4. Savoy as done a Cinnamon Roll and Double Shot Coffee fundraiser for the Jenks band, so that may be an option for us as well

Chaperone Report

- 1. All chaperone spots are filled for the St. Louis trip
 - A couple are still finalizing their BEST paperwork
 - We need to put out a call for more Best trained chaperones

Performance Support

- 1. An extra band practice has been scheduled for 10/19 from 12-4 prior to the football game in Bartlesville
 - Students will be fed at 4
 - Mr. Parker requested Savastanos

Gates and Concession Scheduling

- 1. Gate work ends Late October or early November depending on playoffs
- 2. Can possibly add more winter and spring gate work
 - Would add more earning opportunities for London
 - We'll check with Biddle about more opportunities

Concessions

- 1. Credit Card processing is still on hold
 - We need the machine from Mr. Anthony to test it out
- 2. Having shift leaders is going well
 - 4 consistent shift leaders is a sufficient amount
- 3. Still need concession worker for the evening shift at BTOB
 - 2 student workers have signed up that have food handlers permits
- 4. We didn't find out in time about offering meal deals to visiting BTOB bands
 - We may have band greeters ask if they have already planned meals for their students, or if they would like us to place an additional Chick Fil A order

- 2. Departure is at 8 Friday morning

- Pre-planning is needed to figure out parking for Denny
