THE FESTIVAL CONCERTS

CADOGAN HALL

- 900-seat venue on Sloane Terrace in Chelsea.
- Completed in 1907 to designs by the architect Robert Fellowes Chisholm.
 Now a Grade II listed building noted for its stained glass windows.
- Home of the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra.
- Used by Sir John Eliot
 Gardiner as a recording
 venue for the Mozart
 symphonies.



BAND EQUIPMENT

- All band equipment and instruments will be transported to and from London by an international freight company.
- Includes all instruments (larger and including a trumpet in a standard case upwards), hats and uniforms.
- Smaller instruments that are not included to be carried onto the airplane.
- All Instruments must be packed in hard cases.





TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

BEFORE YOU GO

- Check your passport has a minimum of six months validity at the date of travel i.e. July 2019.
- Take two photocopies of the biographical page of your passport in case you lose the original.
- Check if you need a Visa. Note: US
 Passport holders do not require a
 Visa





ELECTRICAL DEVICES

- Electrical current in England = 220 240 volts.
- Adaptors v Transformers there is a difference!







CELL PHONES

- Smartphones and tablets will all work fine with the higher voltage in England.
- For cell phone service you will need an overseas plan. Speak to your supplier prior to travel.
- Free WiFi in your hotel so download Skype or FaceTime for free face-to-face calls.











CELL PHONE PLANS

- AT&T and Verizon are the main cell phone providers in the US.
- Contact your local service provider to find out if your calling plan has an international service already tied to it.
- Their offers change regularly so make sure you check for the best deals.





CURRENCY

Bills/Notes £5, £10, £20, £50



In the United Kingdom the currency is pounds (£) and pence (p).

100 pence = **1** pound **(£)**

Coins £ 2.00, £ 1.00, 50p, 20p 10p, 5p, 2p, 1p

















Current exchange rate

£ 1.00 = \$ 1.30 \$ 1.00 = 77 pence

MONEY

HOW DO I PAY FOR THINGS IN LONDON?

- Cash, in pounds (£) but don't bring a lot.
- Bank card to use at ATM's.
- Credit cards Visa & MasterCard best.
- Pre-paid cards Visa & MasterCard best.







ATM'S

- Use your bank card to take out Pounds Sterling at ATM's outside most banks and in some shops across London.
- Most common banks are;
 - HSBC
 - Natwest
 - Santander
 - Lloyds
 - RBS





PACKING

Away for just one week – don't over do it!!!

- One check-in bag free— 50lbs in weight and total dimensions 62 inches. Airlines vary so double check on-line.
- One carry on and a purse or laptop bag.
- You may have to take your small instrument as a carry on.









PACKING


- What clothes to pack?
- Temperature in London at New Year;
 - Average Low 37F
 - Average High 48F

AIRPORT PROTOCOL





Approx 20cm

- Don't leave home without your passport.
- Don't be late.
- No ticket required.
- Check-in your suitcase.
- Seats pre allocated.
- Airport security.
- All liquids and gels must be put in plastic bags when travelling on the airplane.



Approx 20cr

YOUR TRANSATLANTIC FLIGHT

- Transatlantic flights all overnight.
- London is 5 hours ahead of Eastern Time (6 hours Central, 7 hours Mountain, 8 hours Pacific).
- Try to get some rest.
- Dinner, breakfast and soft drinks all free on board.
- Movies, TV and music all free.
- Bring your own headset.





ARRIVING IN THE U.K.

- Immigration form.
- UK Border Control check.
- Customs.
- Collect personal luggage.





AIRPORT MEET AND GREET

- After immigration & baggage collection you will make your way to the arrivals hall.
- Met by a professional meet & greet team from Destination Events.

- When you reach your hotel you will be met by your tour assistant.






- A three hour tour of Oxford with Blue Badge guide.

 George's Chapel.







HOW TO USE YOUR CREDIT CARD PLAYER




READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USE!

Your Credit Card mp3 player is simple to operate and fun to use

- 1. Press and hold >II for 3 seconds to power up or off. Press to Play or Pause tracks
- 2. Press I<< for 1 second to select previous track. Press I>> for 1 second to select next track.
- 3. Press and hold I<< to decrease volume. Press and hold |>> to increase volume.
- 4. Press WALK+ for 1 second to select next walk. Press repeatedly to cycle through walk selection.
- 5. Use headphone socket to recharge with cable supplied. Lights stop flashing when fully charged.




