BBPO Board Meeting Minutes Thursday, August 9, 2018 Band Room

Meeting was called to order at 6:34 P.M.

Minutes

- 1. Tracy Rubis motioned to approve minutes from the July meeting
 - Motion was 2nd by Dawn Glimp
 - All approved

Treasurer Report

- 1. Renee presented P & L reports showing numbers from July 2017-July 2018
 - A few notable items were mentioned (for exact details see P & L Statements)
 - BTOB was slightly more profitable in 2017 than the year before
 - 1. Possibly due to Air Grams
 - Fundraising was a little lower last year
 - 1. Due to not having the mattress fundraiser
 - We have an unencumbered carry over amount of \$75,000

2. London accounts

- Danny Ball reported that there are 261 London travelers at this point
 - 156 students
 - Collections are currently at 93%
 - We have \$500,000 toward the \$900,000 total london fee
 - All final payments are due September 1st
- 3. Carrie Cooper reported that information regarding PayPal is in Mike Anthony's hands now
 - If approved, it could be in effect within a week
 - It is possible we'd be able to use it in the concession stands
 - There is a 2.2% administration fee
 - Once PayPal is available an email will be sent out to explain how to account for this fee when making online payments

- This may also open up the option to add a donate button on Cut Time
- 4. Tracy Jackson reported on Guard accounts
 - 8 holds were put on schedules
 - We'll know after schedule pick up if this brought in the fees required for the outstanding guard payments

Concessions

- 1. Cassie Mitchell reported that when the concessions were opened up it was found that the AC, fridges & freezers were all out of order
 - Everything should be in working order now
 - Cleaning is scheduled for saturday from 10-12, all help is appreciated
 - We do not get to sell concessions at the Fall Classic this year
 - We may try to perform next year to be able to get this opportunity
 - We will also check the contract to see if this will be included next year
 - Best Training and Food Handlers Permits are required to work in the stands

Performance Support

- 1. Cathy Peters reported that there will be 10 provided meals this season
 - Menu plans are in the works
 - The first meal will be on 8/13
 - Chick Fil A is planned for that evening
 - 2. Mike King as graciously stepped up to handle water brigade duties
 - Some Tuesdays and Thursdays he may need back up for the beginning of practice
 - Kevin Huffaker was volunteered to handle those days
 - Jeff Beach will help with the water trailer at competitions
 - 3. Derek Meyer reported on the status of props
 - Saturday prop building will begin this week
 - The plan is to disassemble last years props and reuse what we can
 - So far the props for this show seem simpler and easier to move around
 - There are 16 props total

Renee Huffaker reported that she has a working list of parent ambassadors

Fundraising

- 1. Katie Naugle reported on upcoming fundraisers
 - BTOB Ad sales
 - We have sold 2 gold sponsors

 - 1. A W-9 is available if requested by businesses purchasing ads
 - o Planning for the mattress sale is going well
 - Signs will be put up around town soon
 - Self promotion is very easy
 - 1. Encourage everyone to like and share on FB
 - This is the last fundraiser with proceeds available to go toward London
- 2. Tracy Rubis reported that the spirit store will be going live soon
 - A lot of fun stuff has been added
 - Prices have been raised on a few things
 - o This is a general band fundraiser, proceeds do not go toward student accounts
 - The first order will go in at about the 2 week mark
 - The store will remain open for a few weeks after that order as well
 - Items will be changed up after the championships and the store will re-open for Christmas gifts
- 3. A couple of other fundraisers will be coming up soon
 - Greenery
 - Around Thanksgiving
 - Scrip gift cards
 - This will be available after the PayPal account is in place
- 4. Mia reported on BTOB

- o Mr. Parker has been giving the meal plan for approval
- Golf carts and radios are reserved.
- Ad Sales are underway
 - We'll be checking with Pam Taylor to see if she'll do the layout for the program
- Volunteer shirts
